The Problem

Small schools rely heavily on Money provided by the government and more so from fund raising and donations. Unlike larger secondary schools, or schools which have branched into Academy status, it is very difficult for small schools to find funding.

Costs and Expenditure for any school are monitored closely but more so for small primary schools. Releasing funds almost certainly requires approval from multiple sources and can take a great deal of time.

If a service is required outside of the curriculum, such as disposal and recycling, it may take time to get the required approval to release the funds and in many cases the funds are not available.

Willaston Primary school needed quick disposal of old I.T. equipment and telephones to make room for new technology. The items had zero value and due to the small quantity of computers and desk phone they had zero scrap value.

The Solution
